ACT Practice Test: The Practice ACT for sophomores is next Monday, September 18th. Only sophomores will come to school that day; juniors and seniors have a day off! Room assignments will be posted around the school later this week, and the test will commence promptly at 7:55AM, so don't be late!

ACT Test: The registration deadline for the ACT test occurring on October 28th, is September 22nd

College Campus Tours: It's time again for our yearly senior campus tours! Each year, coinciding with the day the sophomores take the ACT exam, SHS gives seniors the opportunity to tour one of 10 different colleges/universities in Utah (there are a couple trips that actually include two colleges).

What: College Campus Tours!

When: Monday, September 18th

Where: Depending on the tour you are taking, buses will be leaving from the ALC Salem campus between 7:00AM and 9:00AM

Cost: \$5 payable to the finance office

How: Starting today, get blue registration form from either the counseling center or Ms. Tuttle (I-215), choose which tour you'd like to take, fill out the form, pay \$5 to finance office, and take the completed registration form and the \$5 receipt to Ms. Tuttle. *This is on a first come first serve basis so register quickly! No registration forms will be accepted after the 15th.*

Detention credit is given according to the following guidelines:

Unexcused Absence (U): Attend 60 minutes of detention at once. You may not, for example, attend 3 times for 20 minutes each. You must attend one full hour at once.

Late Tardy (L): Attend 30 minutes of detention at once.

Tardy (T): Attend 20 minutes of detention at once. You may also attend 40 or 60 minutes of detention if you would like to make up additional tardies.

Sluff (S): Attend 90 minutes of detention on two consecutive days. Example: You attend 60 minutes of detention on Tuesday before or after school and 30 minutes of detention on Wednesday before or after school.

Parking Lots and Parking Information: Just as a reminder, students must purchase parking passes in order to park in the student parking lot located on the west side of the school—please be sure to park in actual parking stalls, or vehicles will be ticketed. The parking lots on the south side of the school and the north side of Oakridge are for employees and visitors **only**—students who park here will be fined. Passes to park in the student lot are **now only \$5 per school year**, so please take advantage of the low cost and forego the greater cost of a parking violation.
