Study Skills

<u>Attendance</u> – Students are expected to attend every class, everyday. Appointments for dentist, having hair cut, or any others should be scheduled for after school hours when possible. Being at school, in class and on time is the first step to good grades.

<u>Student Planner</u> – Students will improve their study skills by keeping their student handbook planner up-to-date each and every day for each and every class period.

<u>Study Skills Lessons and Activities</u> - Students will participate in study skills lessons and show their competency in those skills by completing various worksheets, tasks or having interactions with teachers, other students, parents and/or others.

<u>Homework</u> – Students will increase their grades in every class period by printing their SIS grades, discussions with parent and teachers about grades and missing assignments, and bringing homework to Study Skills not done from other classes.

<u>Credit Recover Packet(s)</u> – Students will make up classes from the past that they did not pass by doing a credit recovery packet.

<u>Reading Book</u> – Students will increase their reading comprehension by reading a book of their choice and writing summaries and thought responses about the book.
