Sign up at the Finance Office. Parent/Teachers Conferences is on Feb. 15th. Need a little HELP with Financial Aid?? The Counseling Office will have a computer lab open to assist in filling out the paperwork online that night.

ACT Preparation Class at SHS

Instructors: Mr. Stewart (Room I-113) and Mr. Frossard (Room C-14)

Cost: \$50.00 (Sign –up and pay fee in the finance office.)

Time: 8 a.m. to Noon for two Saturdays (8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on the 2nd Saturday for those taking the writing portion of the ACT).

Make sure you register on-line for the actual ACT test prior to the specific test deadline at www.actstudent.org The actual test is \$34 without writing and \$49.50 with the writing portion.

Actual ACT Test Dates:

- October 22, 2011 (Registration Deadline Sept.16, 2011 with ACT)
- December 10, 2011 (Registration Deadline November 4, 2011 with ACT)
- April 14, 2012 (Registration Deadline March 9, 2012 with ACT)

**There also is a February 2012 and a June 2012 test—See ACT for details.

Dates prep class is taught for the October Test:

- September 17, 2011
- September 24, 2011

Dates class is taught for the December Test:

- November 5, 2011
- November 12, 2011

Dates class is taught for the April Test:

- March 3, 2012
- March 10, 2012

**No Class will be offered to prepare for the February and June Tests, but you may take one of the 3 scheduled prep classes prior to these tests in order to prepare. Pay \$50 prior to the prep class closest to your test.

Students will be given a review book to use until they have taken the ACT Test. Afterwards, students should return the review book to Mr. Frossard's Room. Students who do not return a review book will be fined within 2 weeks of the actual test date.

Bring a pencil, your receipt and your calculator to Mr. Frossard's room on the first Saturday. Come into the building back by the I-wing near Mr. Lewis' art room.

NURSES CORNER
