Expectations

- I would like students to police each other and me with regard to the class rules.
- **NO CELL PHONES** Cell phones should be turned off and placed on the front of your desk. This is your warning, so if I catch you using it I take it to the administration.
- **NO HATS IN CLASS**

Policies

Late work At the end of each day I will write on the board the things we did that day. If you are absent, read the board and get any assignments out of the assignment box. If you have further questions, talk to me after class. After an absence you have one class period to turn in your work, after that you lose 50% from the assignment.

Hall Passes Each student will receive two hall passes to be used sparingly for the term, once they are gone, they are gone.

Extra Credit Extra Credit will only be available to students who have turned in all their assignments. A few points may be given for unused hall passes, and I generally give an assignment at the term's end, so if you want a good grade be attentive and do your work when you are supposed to.

Required Materials

- Reading book in class every day
- Loose-leaf paper, not paper to be torn out of spiral notebooks
- Pen, blue or black ink
