INTRODUCTIONS

Each member of the council introduced himself/herself to the group. Kami Ashton, Tonya Gage, Sara Hansen, Stacey Hatch, P. J. Maughan, Brian Ostler, Aaron Popham, and Lisa Simmons are new members this year.

OVERVIEW OF COUNCIL RESPONSIBILITIES

Mr. Hylton briefly explained the responsibilities of the school community council with emphasis on preparing a school improvement plan and a TrustLands plan.

ELECTION OF CO-CHAIRS

Aaron Popham was elected as council chair and Debbie Allred was elected vice-chair.

DISTRICT TRAINING

The school district will offer training for school community council members in the board room on October 13th at 3:30 p.m.

The superintendent will hold open forum meetings with council representatives on November 3rd and February 23rd. The November meeting will be held in the Springville High School auditorium. The February meeting will be held at Salem Hills High School.

STATE OFFICE TRAINING

No state training has been scheduled.

COUNCIL RULES OF ORDER

The council approved the previous year's rules of order but changed the meeting time from the second Monday of each month to the second Wednesday of each month to avoid conflict with district collaboration times.

TRUST LANDS VIDEOS

Due to technical problems we were unable to view the videos "Touch the Future" and "Earning for Education." Each council member agreed to view the videos before our October meeting. Mr. Hylton will send the link to the videos to each member.

REVIEW OF SHS STUDENT CLUBS

A list of proposed student clubs for this school year was given to each council member for review. There was some concern that some information on the sheet may not be accurate or complete. The Red Devil Ambassadors probably should be listed as non-curricular. The annual fee for NHS should be \$7 instead

of \$5. There was a request that clubs that go by initials (ASL, HOSA, etc.) spell out the full name of the club or give the meaning of the initials. Where the club is affiliated with a national organization it was requested that a link to the bylaws be provided. The list will be returned to administration and will be presented again in the October meeting.

ADJUSTMENT OF TRUST LANDS FUNDS

Each member was given a copy of the 2016-2017 Springville High School Trust Lands plan and the Nebo School District Trust Lands Allocations (August 10, 2016) spreadsheet. Dr. Kelepolo informed us that due to better than expected performance of the trust and our not using all of the budgeted money for teacher salaries we have approximately \$17,000 that can now be used for other purposes during this school year. The council will need to consider how to best use this money. A top administration priority would be to use \$6000 for library data bases which would be used by students doing research. Other needs include providing resources for our students to better prepare for the ACT, hiring another tracker, or providing more resources for students needing credit recovery. This item will be put on the October meeting agenda and we will further consider how to allocate the extra money.

SCHOOL NEWS AND UPDATES FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dr. Kelepolo spoke of the philosophy of the administration and school to always consider what our real purpose is. "What is our why?" We aim to give every student every opportunity to succeed and progress.
