PBIS PRESENTATION

Tona Graff, and administrative intern, made a presentation on a Positive Behavior Intervention School program she is administering. The objective is to encourage school personnel to recognize and encourage good behavior in students. Teachers are being encouraged to use Red Devil Postcards as a way to let parents and students know that their good behavior is noticed and appreciated. Ms. Graff will be collecting data on how many of these postcard are being sent and by whom. She suggests that we make an extra effort to identify and recognize at-risk students.

REVIEW OF THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

We will add a 6th column to the improvement plan with the heading "Progress Notation."

Goal 1: Change the wording of the goal from "Within 5 years . . ." to "By school year 2021-2022 . . ." No other changes were made to Goal 1.

Goal 2: Change the wording of the goal from "By the end of year five . . ." to "By the end of the 2021-2022 school year . . ."
