REVIEW AND REVISION OF THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Dr. Kelepolo presented the School Improvement/Trustlands Plan to the council. The expected Trust Lands allotment for 2017-2018 is \$141, 217.56. This estimated allotment is \$42,511 more this year than last year but we also expect there will be a \$40,000 decrease in USTAR funds. The largest portion of the money will be spent on teacher and staff salaries. After some discussion the plan was approved as presented.

The plan will be submitted to the school district before the March 23 deadline.

Mr. Hylton will post a copy of the plan to the school website.

ITEMS FROM PRINCIPAL

Friday there will be a recognition assembly for the state boy's basketball championship, other winter sports teams, school Sterling scholars (seven of whom advanced in the competition), and the cast of the Spring play.

OTHER ITEMS FROM THE COUNCIL

There was some discussion of the adjustment and difficulties some students experienced in the recent online administration of the ACT to eleventh graders. Most members of the council expressed a preference for the exam to be given as a paper and pencil exam in the future if possible. It was pointed out that many other school in the state gave the exam as a paper and pencil exam.

Coaches in our school have been trained in CPR and use of defibrillators. EpiPens are available in the office and some students carry their own. Teachers should review which students may need to be treated with EpiPens.
