SAT: Students interested in taking the SAT on the 4th of November need to sign up for the test by this Thursday, Oct. 5th. Sign up online at [sat.org](#)

PSAT/NMSQT: Sophomore and Juniors interested in taking a formal practice SAT on the 14th of October can sign up by paying \$15 on the finance office and bringing the receipt to Mr. Johnson in the counseling office. Juniors who score high on this test may qualify to be entered into the National Merit Scholarship Competition. Please see Mr. Johnson if you have any questions.

ACT Prep Class: We will be offering an ACT prep class on October 7th and 14th to prepare for the October 28th test. Classes run from 8:00 A.M – 12:30 P.M on October 7th and 8:00 A.M -12:00 P.M on October 14th. Students will need to pay \$50 to the Finance office to sign up for the class.

FAFSA night for parents and students: October 25th from 5 - 8 p.m.
