**Swim:** The SHS Red Devil men and women's swim teams are in their mid-season under the direction of head coaches Travis Pope and Kim Green and assistant coaches Sarah Bush, Samantha Ripley, and Sterling Goodwin. Both teams have already had much success in their first few meets with many significant time drops recently compared to the early season. Several swimmers have posted times among the top 24 in the state which should qualify them for the state meet including sophomore Cameron Green who recently broke the school record in the 100 backstroke. The team has two meets coming up this week. They are hosting a swim meet at Springville pool this Thursday, January 11<sup>th</sup> at 3:30pm. This will be the last home meet for the team's 15 seniors. Please come and show your support for them on this senior night where they will be recognized for their contributions to the team. The team will also be competing this Friday and Saturday on January 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> at the Highland invitational meet. The team's regional meet will take place on Saturday January 27<sup>th</sup> at Wasatch in two separate sessions that day. The State meet for those who qualify will be held on February 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> in Bountiful. More information on the Region and State meets will be posted at a later time.
