College Information Day: College Information Day for seniors will be this Wednesday, September 27th. All of the colleges from around the state will be at our school on College Information Day. All seniors need to report to first period and will be excused at 8am to attend an opening session in the auditorium. After the opening session, seniors will be able to visit with the top 3 colleges they are interested in. This will last until lunch and the rest of the day will be normal. Best dress is recommended. A separate email was sent home on Friday with instructions on how to register for a bar code that will be used during the day for students to give the colleges their information if they want to be contacted by them to receive more information.

Important Attendance Information:

- When checking out your student, please call ahead to speed up the check-out process.
- If your student is going to a medical appointment during the school day, please request a medical note from the doctor and bring to the attendance office. This way we can medically excuse their absence, and the attendance reporting will be more accurate.
- You may excuse your students by replying to the email you receive notifying you of an absence. Once you have excused an absence, it takes 24-hours for SIS to update.
- Tardies: Parents are allowed to excuse 1st and 3rd period tardies only. Parents may not excuse students for 2nd and 4th period tardies. Students have the responsibility of getting to class on time between classes.
- You may also excuse your student by leaving a voicemail with Mrs. Taylor, on the attendance line, at any time, not just during school hours. She listens to the messages throughout each day.
- If your student was marked absent or tardy, and you feel it is in error, please have your student visit with the teacher in that class to have that absence/tardy removed.
- Unless you need to check out your student immediately, you may leave a message to excuse your student's absence. Our attendance secretary checks the voicemail throughout each day.
